### Paul Endacott 1902-1997

Paul S. Endacott, a 1923 engineering graduate, was KU's first honors student graduate and captain of the 1923 KU championship basketball team. He was one of six KU alumni to serve as president of Phillips Petroleum Co. in the first half of the 20th century. In his retirement, Mr. Endacott envisioned programs to serve retired faculty and staff, and he and his family provided gifts to KU Endowment to help construct the Adams Alumni Center.

To provide ongoing support of retiree services and activities, he established the Expressions of Appreciation Fund for alumni and friends to honor faculty and staff.

### Oral History Project

In 1984, Raymond Nichols, chancellor emeritus and the first Endacott Society president (originally founded in 1983 as the KU Retirees' Club), started an Oral History Project—recording interviews with retired faculty and staff about their lives and careers. More than 700 oral histories are on file in the Spencer Research Library and in the Endacott Society office in the Adams Alumni Center. Endacott members are regularly recruited to conduct and transcribe interviews. The project is financed by a KU Endowment designated fund and a fund within the Endacott Society budget.
